



Cascadia Water Trail Campsites

Burrows Island *The North Sound Area*

Find a San Juan island within minutes of Anacortes – travel to Burrows Island, made of the same rock as the greater archipelago. Protected by Burrows and Allan Pass, the campsite looks at the populated eastern shore of Anacortes. Boat around to outer Burrows Island to view the lighthouse and look westward over Rosario Strait to the major portion of the San Juans.

Natural History.

Washington State Parks has increased its holding on the island to protect more pristine San Juan Island habitat. Respect the land and don't hide away from the campsite. There is abundant sea life clinging to the cliffs and swimming nearby.
