



Cascadia Water Trail Campsites

Kinney Point *The North Sound Area*

Marrowstone Island is surrounded by fascinating waters. Killisut Harbor and Scow Bay are protected and there's Ports Hadlock and Townsend nearby. Admiralty Inlet to the east can have lively currents and traffic. Kinney Point, just inside Marrowstone, on Oak Bay, is a true island getaway.. Accessible only by boat, the 68 acre property feels secluded.

Natural History.

Kinney Point is Puget Sound high bank with exposed bluffs to the south. Watch for bald eagles cruising over the shallow waters around the point and using the updrafts to full advantage.
