



Cascadia Water Trail Campsites

Laughlin Cove *Hood Canal*

Public access on the eastern shores of the Hood Canal is very limited. The Trust for Public Land (TPL), recognizing this need, purchased the property to save it from further development. The property was later transferred to Kitsap County Park Department. TPL also purchased the tidelands along its 1,200 foot shoreline and calls the cove by the name of the former owners.

Natural History.

Chinom Point, just south of the site, marks the boundary of the Upper Hood Canal Watershed. The northern limit of this drainage area is just north of the Port Gamble S'Klallam reservation north of Port Gamble Bay.
