



## Cascadia Water Trail Campsites

### Obstruction Pass *The San Juan Islands*

Located on the largest island of the San Juans, Obstruction Pass State Park has the longest beach on Orcas Island. Washington State Parks is thoughtfully changing camping practices to accommodate those arriving by boat and foot for the benefit of island residents and visitors.

#### Natural History.

Obstruction Island, across the Pass, was offered for about \$180,000 in the early 1960's. Two Seattle high school teachers purchased the island. In July, 1964, E.M. Graham of Shaw Island, the 86-year-old San Juan County Engineer, surveyed the island. He and his helper, an 11-year-old boy, traveled throughout the islands by canoe.
