



## Cascadia Water Trail Campsites

### **Odlin County Park** *The San Juan Islands*

The sandy bay that fronts most of Odlin Park is a welcome relief from the rocky cliffs surrounding many of the San Juan Islands. The park is backed by Department of Natural Resources forest and has 4,000 feet of shoreline.

#### **Natural History.**

The steep sea floor is ideal for scuba divers. The currents around Upright Head provide good nutrients for underwater species and sometimes trouble for kayakers.
